Coverage of this report

- This report provides a league table of top 200 banks in CEE ranked by their total unconsolidated assets value as of the end of 2004
- Report covers 15 countries from the region. Russia, Ukraine, Belarus and Moldova have been excluded

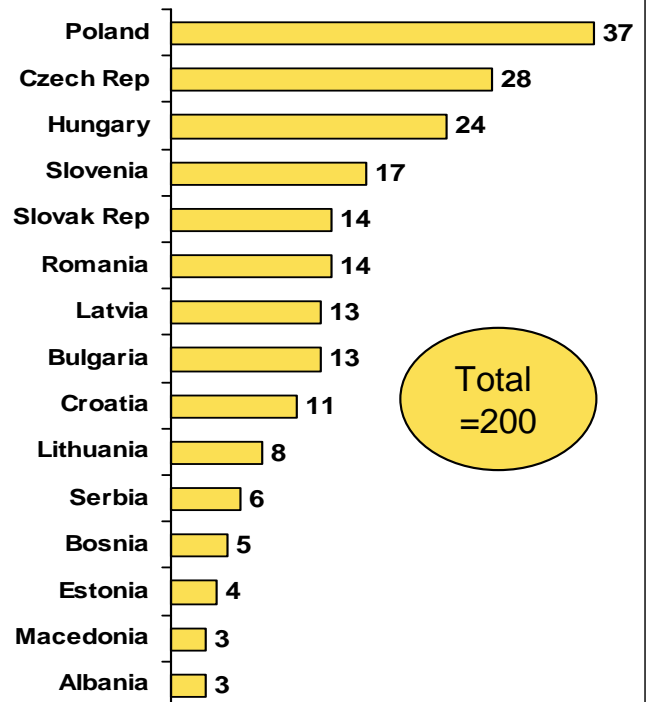
Some statistics on the 200 CEE banks list

- Total value of assets of all banks on the list was close to EUR 409 billion as of 2004
- Assets of banks from the list represent 89% of total banking assets in the region
- Balance sum of the bank No.200 from the list was close to EUR 254 million
